Who He Is

2:19 - Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up (speaking of the temple of His body).

3:13 - No man has ascended up to heaven, but He that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.

4:13 & 14 - Whosoever drinks of this water shall thirst again: but whosoever drinks of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

5:17 - My Father works hitherto, and I work.

5:19 - The Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do: for whatsoever things He does, these also the Son does likewise.

5:20 & 21 - The Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does: and He will show Him greater works than these, that ye may marvel. For the Father raises up the dead, and quickens them; even so the Son quickens whom He will.

5:26 & 27 - For the Father has life in Himself; so has He given to the Son to have life in Himself, and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of man.

5:30 - I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father Who has sent Me.

5:32 - There is another that bears witness of Me; and I know that the witness which He witnesses of Me is true.

5:36 & 37 - But I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father has given Me to finish, the same works that I do bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent me, and the Father Himself, Who has sent me, has borne witness of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His shape.

5:41 - I receive not honor from men.

5:43 - I am come in My Father's name, and you receive Me not: if another shall come in his own name, him you will receive.

5:46 & 47 - For if you believed Moses, you would have believed Me: for he wrote of Me. But if you believe not his writings, how shall you believe My words?

6:32 & 33 - My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. The Bread of God is He Who comes down out of heaven and gives life to the world.

6:35 - I am the Bread of Life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger: and he that believes on me shall never thirst.

6:38 - I came down from heaven not to do My own will, but the will of the Father.

6:51 - I am the living bread which came down from heaven.

6:51 - If any man eats of this bread, he shall live forever. This bread is that I give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

6:63 - The words that I speak to you are spirit and life.

7:7 - The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify that its works are evil.

7:16 - My doctrine is not Mine, but His that sent Me.

7:18 - He that speaks of himself seeks his own glory: but He Who seeks the glory and is eager for the Honor of Him Who sent Him, He is true, and there is no unrighteousness or falsehood in Him.

7:28 - Do you know Me, and do you know where I am from? I have not come on My own authority and of My own accord and as self-appointed, but the One Who sent Me is true; and Him you do not know.

7:29 - I am from Him, and He has sent Me.

7:33 - Yet a little while I am with you, and then I go unto Him that sent Me.

7:37 - If any man thirsts, let him come unto Me, and drink.

8:12 - I am the Light of the world; he that follows Me will not walk in darkness but shall have the Light of Life.

8:14 - Though I bear record of Myself, yet My record is true: for I know where I came from and where I am going; but you do not know where I come from or where I am going.

8:14 - I know from where I came and where I go.

8:15 - You judge after the flesh; I judge no man.

8:16 - And yet if I judge, My judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent Me.

8:18 - I am One that bear witness of Myself, and the Father that sent Me bears witness of Me.

8:19 - You neither know Me, nor my Father: if you had known Me, you should have known My Father also.

8:21 - I go My way, and you shall seek Me, and shall die in your sins: whither I go, you cannot come.

8:23 - I am from above.

8:25 - (*When asked: 'Who are you?'*) Even the same that I said unto you from the beginning.

8:26 - I have many things to say and to judge of you: but He that sent Me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of Him.

8:28 - When the Son of Man is lifted up (on the cross) you will know that I am He and that I do nothing of Myself, but I as My Father has taught Me, I speak these things.

8:29 - He Who sent Me is with me.

8:29 - The Father has not left Me alone, for I do always do those things that please Him.

8:38 - I speak that which I have seen with My Father, and you do that which you have seen with your father.

8:42 - He proceeded from the Father.

8:42 - If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from

God; neither came I of Myself, but He sent Me.

8:49 - I have not a devil; but I honor My Father, and you do dishonor Me.

8:50 - I seek not My own glory; there is One Who seeks and judges.

8:54 - If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing: it is My Father that honors Me, of Whom you say, that He is your God.

8:55 - Yet you have not known Him; but I know Him: and if I should say I don't know Him, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know Him and keep His saying.

8:58 - Before Abraham was, I AM.

9:4 - I must work the works of Him that sent Me.

9:5 - As long as I am in the world, I am the Light of the world.

10:1-6 - Jesus is the Shepherd of the sheep (shown in parable)

10:7 - I am the Door of the sheep.

10:11 - I am the Good Shepherd: the Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

10:17 - My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life, that I might take it again.

10:18 - No man takes it (life) from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of My Father.

10:25 - I told you, and you believed not: the works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me.

10:30 - I and My Father are One.

10:32 - Many good works have I shown you from My Father; for which of those works do you stone Me?

10:36 - Say you of Him, Whom the Father has sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

10:37 - I do the works of My Father.

10:38 - The Father is in Me, and I in Him.

11:25 - I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believes in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live.

12:23 - The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.

12:27 & 28 - Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save Me from this hour: but for this cause I came unto this hour. Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again.

12:30 - This voice came not because of Me, but for your sakes.

12:32 - And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto Me.

12:44 - He that believes on Me, believes not on Me, but on Him that sent Me.

12:45 - He that sees Me sees Him that sent Me.

12:46 - I am come into the world, that whosoever believes on Me should not abide in darkness.

12:49 - I have not spoken of Myself; but the Father which sent Me, He gave Me a

commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.

12:50 - And I know that His commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto Me, so I speak.

13:31 - Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him.

13:32 - If God be glorified in him, God shall also glorify Him in Himself, and shall straightway glorify Him.

14:7 - If you know Me, you know the Father also.

14:9 - He that has seen Me has seen the Father.

14:10 - The words I speak unto you I speak not of Myself: but the Father that dwells in Me, He does the works.

14:30 - The prince of this world has nothing in Me.

14:31 - I do as the Father commanded Me so that the world may know that I love the Father and that I do only what the Father has instructed Me to do.

15:1 - I am the vine and My Father is the husbandman.

15:23 - He who hates Me also hates My Father.

15:24 - If I hadn't done among them the work which no other man did, they wouldn't be guilty of sin: but now they have hated both Me and My Father.

15:25 - But this is come to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, "They hated Me without a cause."

16:5 - Now I go My way to Him that sent Me.

16:28 - I came forth from the Father and have come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

16:32 - The hour is now come when you shall leave Me alone: and yet I'm not alone because the Father is with Me.

16:33b - In the world you will have tribulation: but be of good cheer: I have overcome the world.

17:4 - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work that You gave Me to do.

17:5 - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): Now glorify Me along with Yourself with the glory that I had with You before the world was.

17:24b - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): You loved Me before the foundation of the world.

17:21b - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): ...that they may all be one, just as You, Father, are in Me and I in You.

18:11 - The cup which My Father has given Me, shall I not drink it?

18:20 - I spoke openly to the world: I have always taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, where the Jews always congregate; and in secret I have said nothing.

18:23 - (Jesus before Pontius Pilate): If I've spoken evil, tell Me what was wrong with it. But if I spoke rightly and properly, why do you strike Me?

18:36 - (Jesus before Pontius Pilate): -My kingdom is not of this world: if My kingdom

were of this world, then would My servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews. But as it is, My kingdom is not from here.

20:17 - Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to My Father: but go to My brethren and say unto them, I ascend unto My Father, and your Father; and to My God, and your God.

Why He Came

3:14 & 15 - And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.

3:16 - For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

3:17 - For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.

4:34 - My meat is to do the will of Him that sent Me, and to finish His work.

6:38 - For I came down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him that sent Me.

6:51 - I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live forever; and the bread that I will give is My flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

7:28 - Do you know Me, and do you know where I am from? I have not come on My own authority and of My own accord and as self-appointed, but the One Who sent Me is true; and Him you do not know.

7:29 - But I know Him (the Father): for I am from Him, and He has sent Me.

9:4 - I must work the works of Him that sent Me.

10:10 - I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

10:11 - I am the Good Shepherd: the Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

10:15 - As the Father knows Me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down My life for the sheep.

10:16 - I have other sheep which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear My voice: and there shall be one fold, and one Shepherd.

11:42 - (Prayer to the Father): I know You always hear and listen to Me, but I have said this on account for the benefit of the people who stand by, so that they may believe that You have sent Me.

12:27 - Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save Me from this hour: but for this cause I came unto this hour.

12:31 - Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out.

12:32 - And I, if I be lifted up (on the cross) from the earth, will draw all men unto Me.

12:45 - He that sees Me, sees Him that sent Me.

12:46 - I am come into the world, that whosoever believes on Me should not abide in darkness.

12:47 - If any man hears my words and believes not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

15:13-14 - Greater love has no man that this, that a man lay down his life for his friends, you are my friends if you do whatsoever I command you.

18:37 - (Jesus before Pontius Pilate): You say that I am a king. To this end I was born, for this cause I came into the world, that I should bear witness unto the Truth. Everyone who is of the Truth hears My voice.

19:30 - It is finished.

Salvation

3:5 - Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

3:14 & 15 - And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.

3:16 - For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

3:17 - For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.

5:24 - Verily, verily I say unto you, He that hears My word, and believes on Him that sent Me, has everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

5:28 & 29 - The hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear His voice, and shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

5:39 & 40 - Search the scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life: and they are they which testify of Me. And you will not come to Me, that you might have life.

6:35 - I am the Bread of Life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger: and he that believes on me shall never thirst.

6:37 - All whom My Father gives to Me shall come to me.

6:37 - And he who comes to Me, I will in no wise cast out.

6:39 - And this is the Father's will which has sent Me, that of all which He has give Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

6:40 - And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which sees the Son, and believes on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

6:44 - No man can come to Me, except the Father which has sent Me draw Him: and I

will raise him up at the last day.

6:51 - I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eats of this bread, he shall live forever: and this bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

6:56 - He that eats My flesh, and drinks My blood (appropriates His life and the saving merit of His blood), dwells in Me, and I in Him.

6:58 - Those who eat this bread will live forever.

7:37-39 - If any man thirsts, let him come unto Me, and drink. He that believes on Me, as the scripture has said, 'out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.' (But this He spoke of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive for the Holy Ghost was not yet given because Jesus was not yet glorified).

8:12 - I am the light of the world: he that follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

8:24 - If you don't believe in Me, you will die in your sins.

8:28 - When the Son of Man is lifted up (on the cross) you will know that I am He and that I do nothing of Myself, but as My Father has taught Me, I speak these things.

8:36 - If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.

8:51 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keeps My saying, he shall never see death.

10:9 - I am the Door (of the sheep): by Me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out and find pasture.

10:11 - I am the Good Shepherd: the Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

10:15 - As the Father knows Me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down My life for the sheep.

10:28 - And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of My hand.

10:29 - My Father, which gave them to Me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of My hand.

11:25 - I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believes in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live.

11:26 - Whosoever lives and believes in Me shall never die.

12:27 - Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save Me from this hour: but for this cause I came unto this hour.

12:32 - And I, if I be lifted up (on the cross) from the earth, will draw all men unto Me.

12:36 - While you have Light, believe in the light, that you may be the children of Light.

12:44 - He that believes on Me, believes not on Me, but on Him that sent Me.

12:46 - I am come into the world, that whosoever believes on Me should not abide in darkness.

12:47 - If any man hears My words and believes not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

12:48 - He that rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has One that judges him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

14:1 - If you believe in God, believe in Me.

14:6 - I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes to the Father, but by Me.

14:11 - Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me; or else believe Me for the very works' sake.

17:2 - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): You have given Him power over all flesh so that He (the Son) may give eternal life to as many as You have given Him.

17:3 - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): And this is eternal life, that they might know Thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, Whom Thou has sent.

The Holy Spirit

7:37-39 - If any man thirsts, let him come unto Me, and drink. He that believes on Me, as the scripture has said, 'out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.' (But this He spoke of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive for the Holy Ghost was not yet given because Jesus was not yet glorified).

14:16 & 17 - I will ask the Father and He will give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever, even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees Him not, neither knows Him: but you know Him; for He dwells with you and will be in you.

14:26 - But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

15:26 - But when the Comforter comes, Whom I will send to you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, He shall testify of Me.

16:7 - It is expedient that I go away: for if I don't, the Comforter won't come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.

16:8-11 - When He comes He'll reprove the world of sin and of righteousness and of judgment. Of sin, because they don't believe in Me; of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you won't see Me any longer; of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.

16:13 - Howbeit when the Spirit of truth is come, He will guide you into all truth: for He shall not speak of Himself: but whatsoever He shall hear, *that* shall He speak: and He will show you things to come.

16:14 - He will glorify Me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall show it unto you.

16:15 - All things that the Father has are Mine. That is what I meant when I said that the Spirit will take the things that are Mine and reveal it to you.

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Judgment

5:22 & 23 - For the Father judges no man, but has committed all judgment unto the Son; that all men should honor the Son, even as they honor the Father. He that honors not the Son honors not the Father which has sent Him.

5:26 & 27 - For the Father has life in Himself; so has He given to the Son to have life in Himself, and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of man.

5:30 - I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father Who has sent Me.

7:7 - He judges no man.

8:15 - You judge after the flesh; I judge no man.

8:16 - And yet if I judge, My judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent Me.

8:26 - I have many things to say and to judge of you: but He that sent Me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of Him.

8:50 - I seek not My own glory; there is One Who seeks and judges.

12:47 - If any man hears My words and believes not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

12:48 - He that rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has One that judges him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

Relationship to Us

5:42 - But I know you, that you have not the love of God in you.

5:43 - I am come in My Father's name, and you receive Me not: if another shall come in his own name, him you will receive.

6:39 - This is the Father's will which has sent Me, that of all which He has given Me, I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

6:56 - He dwells in those who drink His blood and eat His flesh (those who appropriate Christ's life and saving merit of His blood).

7:37 - If any man thirsts, let him come unto Me, and drink.

8:19 - You neither know Me, nor my Father: if you had known Me, you should have known My Father also.

8:23 - You are from beneath; I am from above: you are of this world; I am not of this world.

8:31 - If you continue in My word, then you are my disciples indeed.

8:32 - And you shall know the Truth and the Truth shall set you free.

8:36 - If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.

10:14 - I am the Good shepherd and know my sheep, and am known of Mine.

10:27 - My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.

11:40 - Did I not tell you that if you would believe, you would see the glory of God?

12:25 - He that loves his life will lose it; and he that hates his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.

12:26 - If any man serves me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also My servant be: if any man serves Me, him will My Father honor.

12:35 - Yet a little while is the Light with you. Walk while you have the Light, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walks in darkness knows not where he goes.

12:36 - While you have Light, believe in the light, that you may be the children of Light.

12:46 - I am come into the world, that whosoever believes on Me should not abide in darkness.

13:8 -(Washing the disciples' feet): If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me.

13:20 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that receives whomsoever I send receives Me; and he that receives Me receives Him that sent Me.

13:33-35 - Little children, yet a little while I am with you. Ye shall seek Me: and as I said unto the Jews, 'Whither I go, ye cannot come', so now I say to you. A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another.

14:2 - In My Father's house are many mansions. I go and prepare a place for you.

14:3 - I will come again and receive you unto Myself that where I am, you may be also.

14:12 - He who believes on Me, the works I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go to the Father.

14:13 - Whatsoever you will ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14:14 - If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

14:15 - If you love Me, keep My commandments.

14:18 - I will not leave you comfortless (orphans): I will come to you.

14:19 - Yet a little while, and the world sees Me no more; but you see me: because I live, you shall live also.

14:20 - At that day you shall know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

14:21 - He who has my commandments, and keeps them, he it is that loves me: and he that loves Me shall be loved of My Father, and I will love him, and will manifest Myself to him.

14:23 - If a man loves Me, he will keep My words and My Father will love him and We will come unto him and make Our abode with him.

14:24 - The word which you hear is not mine, but the Father' which sent me.

14:27 - My peace I leave you, My peace I give to you: not as the world gives do I give to you. Don't let your heart be troubled nor afraid.

14:28 & 29 - I am going away and I will come back to you. If you really loved Me you'd be glad because I'm going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. I'm telling you this before it happens so that when it does occur, you might believe.

15:4 - Abide in Me and I will abide in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can you, except you abide in Me.

15:5 - I am the vine and you are the branches: He that abides in Me, and I in him, the same brings forth much fruit for without Me you can do nothing.

15:7 - If you abide in Me and My words abide in you, you shall ask what you will and it shall be done unto you.

15:8 - My Father is glorified when you bear fruit; so shall you be my disciples.

15:9 - As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you.

15:10 - If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

15:11 - I have spoken these things that My joy might remain in you and that your joy might be full.

15:12 - This is My commandment that you love one another as I have loved you.

15:13-14 - Greater love has no man that this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do whatsoever I command you.

15:15 - From now on, I call you not servants, for the servant knows not what his lord does: but I have called you friends; for all things I've heard from My Father I have made known to you.

15:16 - You have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that you should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever you will ask of the Father in My name, He may give it to you.

15:17 - These things I command you that you love one another.

15:18 - If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you.

15:19 - I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

15:20 - If they've persecuted Me, they will also persecute you.

15:21 - All these things they'll do unto you for My name's sake, because they don't know Him Who sent Me.

16:2 & 3 - They will put you out of the synagogues: yes, the time is coming when those who kill you will think they do God service. And these things they will do because they haven't known the Father, nor Me.

16:16 - In a little while you'll no longer see Me, and again after a short while you will see Me, because I go to the Father.

16:20 - You shall weep and lament but the world will rejoice. But your sorrow will be turned into joy.

16:22 - I will see you again and your heart will rejoice and no one can take that joy from you.

16:23 - Whatsoever you shall ask of the Father in My name, He shall give it to you.

16:24 - Up to this time, you've asked nothing in My name: ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

16:25 - I've spoken in proverbs but the time is coming when I will show you plainly of the Father.

16:26-27 - At that day, you shall ask in My name and I won't ask the Father for you because the Father tenderly loves you because you've loved Me, and have believed that I came out from God.

16:33 - I've spoken these things to you that in Me you might have peace. In the world you will have tribulation: but be of good cheer: I have overcome the world.

17:20-21 - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): I don't pray for these (disciples) alone, but for all the others who will come to believe in Me through their word; that they may all be one, just as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be one in Us, so that the world may believe that You have sent Me.

17:22-23 - And the glory You gave Me I have given them; that they may be one even as We are One: I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in one; and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them, as You have loved Me.

17:24 - Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given Me, be with Me where I am; that they may behold My glory, which You have given Me: because You loved Me before the foundation of the world.

17:25 - (Jesus' prayer to the Father): O Righteous Father, the world has not known You: but I have known You and these have known that You have sent Me.
